Everyone can see the full range of toys and equipment available, but only full members can reserve items.

To reserve an item you must first log in using your Allsorts membership number. If you don't have a membership number, please email Julie at julie@allsortsglos.org.uk or telephone her on 07582 378422.

From the Toy Library page you can search for any item in the Toy Library. You can look for specific items using the search box, narrowing your search criteria down to category type (eg sensory, activity, pretend play), keywords (eg autism, balance, bob the builder), name (eg tunnel, bike, ball), or a specific toy code (eg A55, S106). Alternatively, just click 'Go!' and scroll down to view the complete Toy Library stock.

To reserve an item, just click on the 'Reserve' button. Items that are out on loan will be clearly labelled as such in red, next to the item on the screen. Underneath the product description it will also tell you if there is a waiting list for the item. You can still reserve an on-loan item!

If you reserve an item, you will be notified when it is ready for collection from the Trinity Rooms.

Services for young disabled people aged 18 – 25

For some time our members have been telling us that there is very little for young people to do once they become 18. We know it has been a gap in what Allsorts offer its members and the time has come for us to do something about it. We are always keen to find out what members want from Allsorts, so in this newsletter we wanted to let you know about two new things that are happening this autumn, and that we hope will generate more ideas and more choice for young people in the future.

Young People's Voice

The first of these is that we are planning to hold an event, run by young people for young people aged 16 - 25, on November 17 at National Star College. This event will be a chance for disabled young people from across Gloucestershire to meet up and talk to each other, and to let us know what they think organisations like Allsorts should be doing for them.

Allsorts Enterprise

Members tell us that there are few opportunities for disabled young people to get work experience, work placements or to find employment. Allsorts are planning to set up a small business where young people can get the training and experience necessary to help them move towards finding paid employment. We are starting from a very small seed in the form of an ice cream bike! Some of you may already have seen the bike in action at the Allsorts Family Festival on 29 August. The plan is to make and sell ice cream to the public, but also to use it to sell other things – the freezer can be removed and replaced by anything we choose – homemade crafts, Christmas cards, cream teas, potted plants – making it a low cost, flexible and fun business for our Allsorts young people to get involved with.
